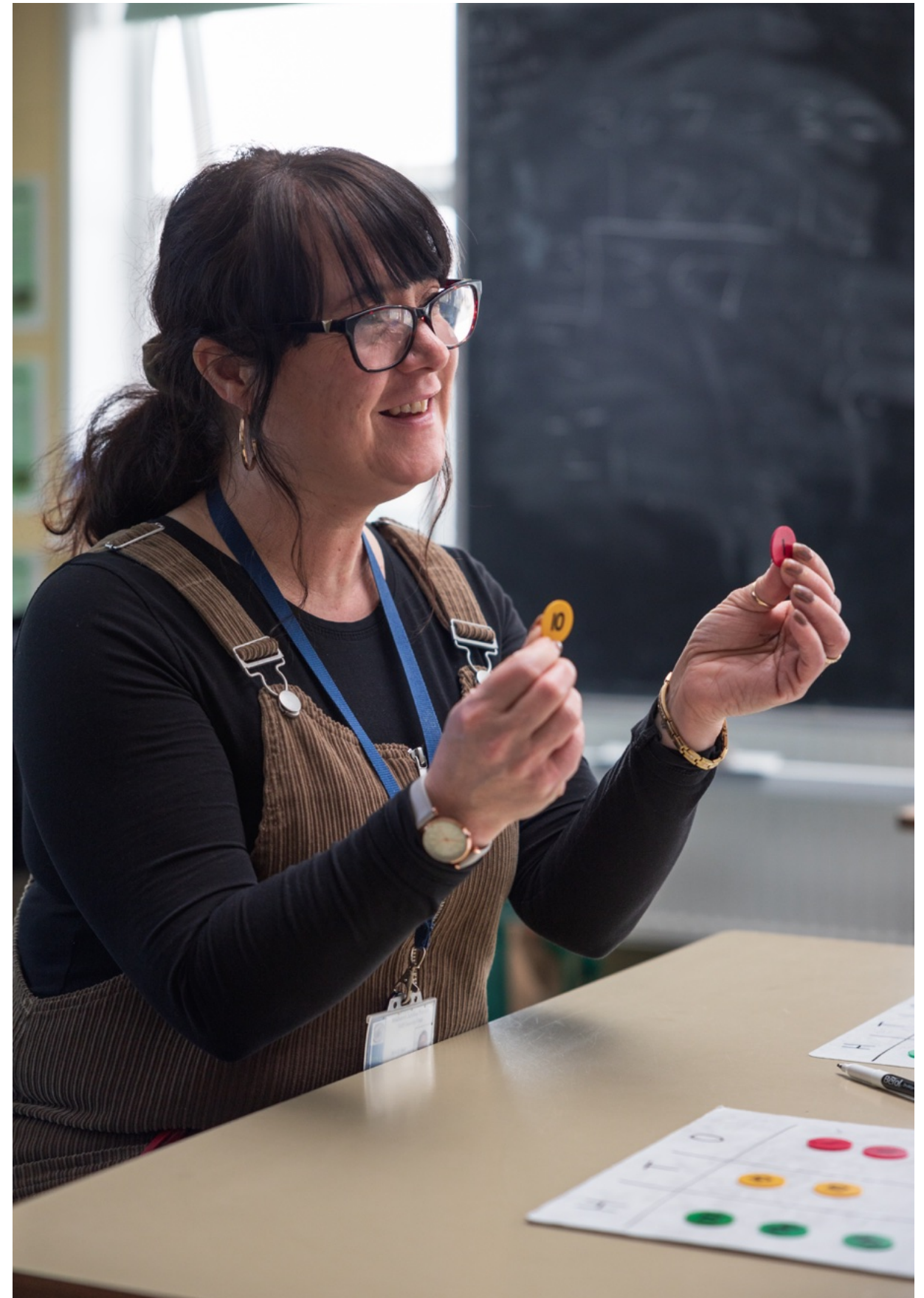

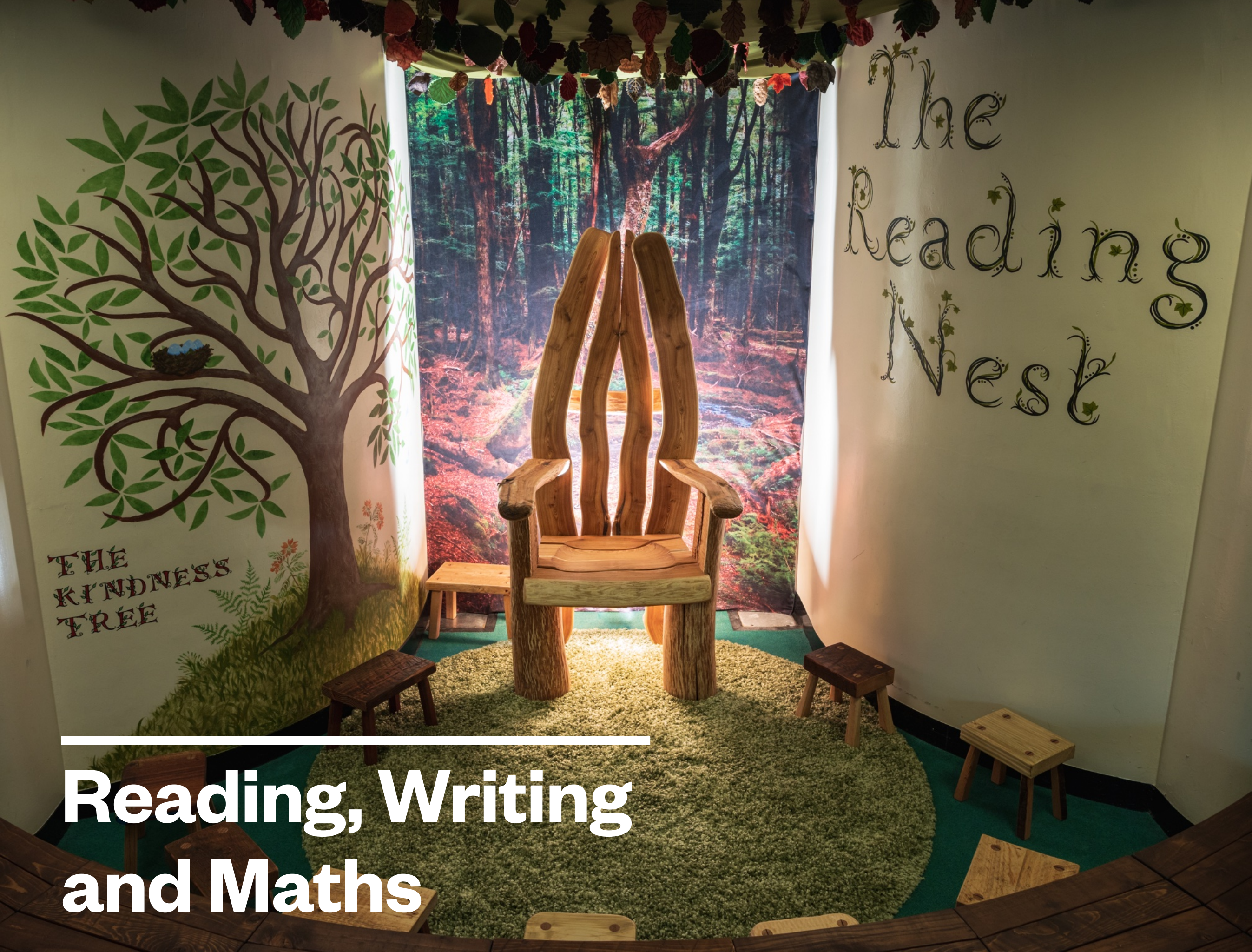
SEN/Higher Ability

English, Reading and Writing

At Wallsend Jubilee Primary, we believe that a quality literacy (English) curriculum should develop children's love of reading, writing and discussion. We aim to inspire an appreciation of our rich and varied literary heritage and a habit of reading widely and often.

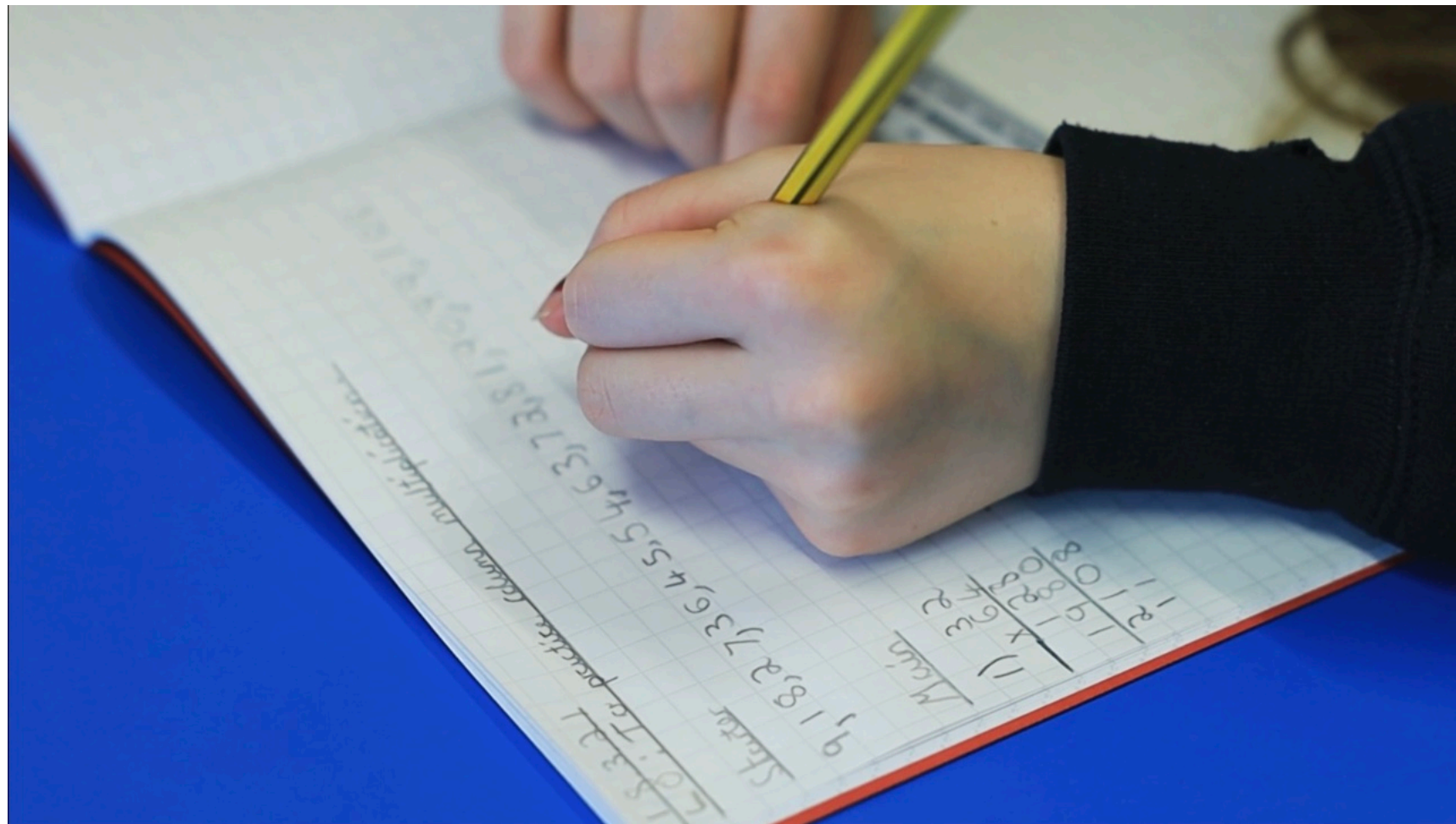
We recognise the importance of nurturing a culture where children take pride in their writing, can write clearly and accurately and adapt their language and style for a range of contexts. We want to inspire children to be confident in the art of speaking and listening and who can use discussion to communicate and further their learning.

We believe that children need to develop a secure knowledge-base in literacy, which follows a clear pathway of progression as they advance through the primary curriculum. We believe that a secure basis in literacy skills is crucial to a high-quality education and will give our children the tools they need to participate fully as a member of society.



Maths

At Wallsend Jubilee Primary School, we want every child to be happy and enthusiastic learners of Mathematics, and to be eager to achieve their very best in order to fulfil their talents. We firmly believe that the recipe for success is high quality first teaching in Mathematics, which is central to the life of our happy, caring school. We want all of our children *"To be the best they can be"*. At Wallsend Jubilee Primary School, we strive for our children to be successful and proficient mathematicians who can solve problems, fluently recall facts rapidly and reason mathematically while justifying their reasoning. This will provide them with the essential life skills required to be financially capable while understanding and contributing to the world around them. It will allow them to create solutions to problems in a range of settings. To be successful, pupils should display the following attributes: curiosity, resourcefulness, determination, flexibility and bravery. We recognise that maths is essential to everyday life, critical to science, technology and engineering, and necessary for financial literacy and most forms of employment. We aim to promote a love of maths while providing a high quality mathematics education with a mastery approach so that all children can: become fluent in the fundamentals of mathematics; reason mathematically and solve problems by applying their mathematics.



Our Approach to the Curriculum

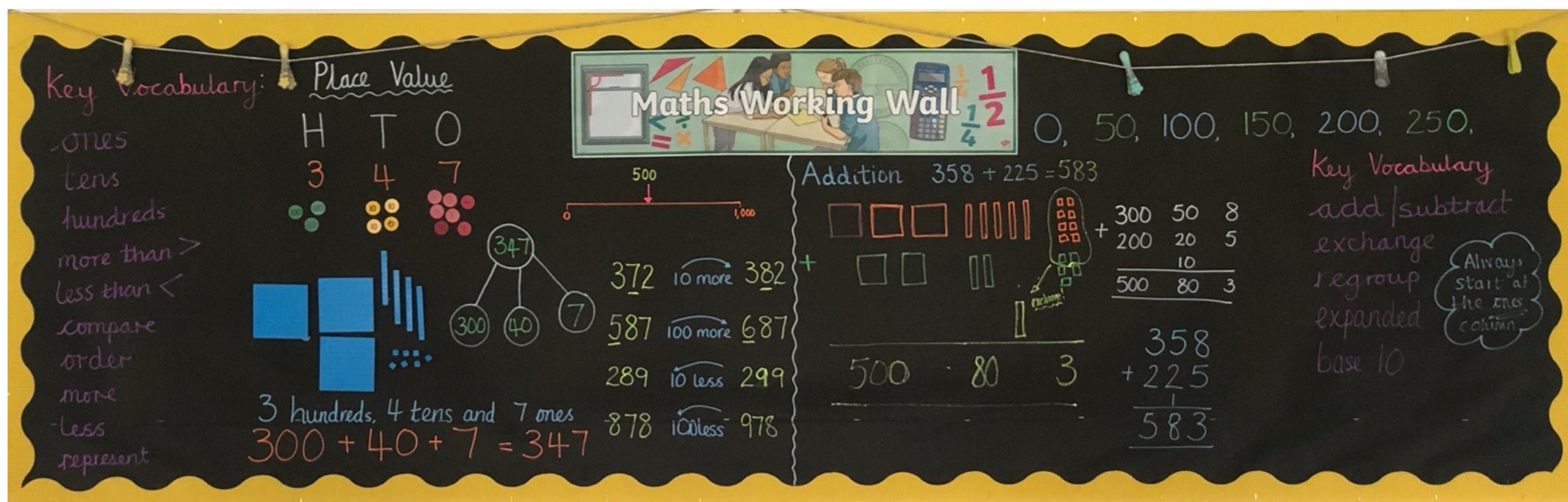
At Wallsend Jubilee Primary School, we believe that every child is unique and has a range of gifts, talents and skills!

Our curriculum is the driving force that ensures that all children are given the opportunity to enjoy their education and thrive in a well thought out, progressive and stimulating environment. Our curriculum includes not only the formal requirements of the National Curriculum, but also a range of additional opportunities in order to promote learning, personal growth and development.

We have designed our curriculum to ensure that our children have the experiences and building blocks to support them in reaching their own potential, sparking new interests and passion and having a love of learning. This will support the children in becoming employable adults who live healthy lifestyles and grasp opportunities to broaden their horizons.

We seek to equip children with the necessary knowledge and understanding to prepare them for the future by focusing on the development of the 6R thinking skills: reflection, resilience, risk-taking, resourcefulness, responsibility and reasoning. This alongside fundamental British values is central to our curriculum. We will challenge, inspire and question children's thinking which will spark and ignite their curiosity for learning.

Behaviour Management

We are a caring inclusive school and aim for every member of our school community to feel valued and respected. We all have the right to be treated well and fairly.
