Wraparound Care: Monday–Friday | 3:15pm – 5:45pm

For children from Nursery to Year 6

Our After School Club provides high-quality wraparound care in a safe, secure and nurturing environment. The provision is managed by Miss Hope and Miss Graham, who oversee the day-to-day organisation and ensure that children’s safety, wellbeing and enjoyment are at the heart of the club.

The club supports children at the end of the school day by offering a calm transition from learning into play, relaxation and enrichment activities.

Aims of the Provision

- To provide a safe, inclusive and well-supervised environment
- To promote children’s emotional wellbeing, confidence and independence
- To support positive behaviour and relationships
- To offer a balance of creative, physical and quiet activities
- To support families through reliable wraparound care

What Children Experience

Children are supported by familiar staff who know them well. Activities are planned to reflect children’s interests and developmental needs and are adapted so that all pupils, including those with SEND, can participate fully.

Each session includes:

- Opportunities to relax and socialise after the school day
- A range of structured and child-led activities

- Access to physical activity, indoors and outdoors
- A healthy snack and drink, promoting good eating habits
- Time and support for homework or reading, if children choose

(Activities are age-appropriate, supervised and rotated regularly.)

Craft activities • Bracelet making • Sewing • Lego

Wednesday

Gardening • Arts and crafts • Table tennis • Basketball

Friday

Creative crafts • Board games • Table football • TV time (calm end to the week) •
Outdoor play

Children are encouraged to make choices and develop independence while staff provide clear routines, guidance and support.
