Pupil Responsibilities (Child code of conduct)

- Promote positive behaviour and mutual respect
- Keep parents/carers informed about their child's progress and wellbeing
- Provide regular opportunities for communication (e.g. meetings, reports, newsletters)
- Support pupils' emotional wellbeing and development
- Ensure homework is appropriate and supports learning
- Teach pupils how to stay safe online and use technology responsibly
- Address concerns, including online safety issues, promptly and fairly

Parents'/Carers' Responsibilities

We will:

- Ensure our child attends school regularly, on time, and is well-prepared for the day
- Inform the school promptly of any absence or concerns
- Support the school's behaviour policy and encourage good behaviour
- Encourage our child to complete homework and support their learning at home
- Attend meetings and discussions about our child's progress where possible
- Respect and support the school community, staff, and other families
- Ensure our child is appropriately dressed in school uniform (if applicable)
- Support safe and responsible use of the internet and devices at home
- Monitor our child's online activity, including social media and games where appropriate
- Report any online safety concerns to the school when they may affect wellbeing
