

a) add the ONES (7 +
5= 12.) The 2 ones go in
the ones column and the 1
ten goes underneath in the
tens column
b) add the TENS (40 +
20 + 10= 70) Don't forget
the 10 that we carried!
c) add the HUNDREDS (
300 + 100)= 400
