



<u>Science</u> In Science this term we will be looking at ‘Animals including humans’. We will cover variation, sorting animals into different categories to understand how they are similar and how they are different. We will also learn about off-spring, this includes learning about what makes them grow up to become a healthy adult. ‘Uses of everyday material’ including different types of materials and their properties . Investigating different types of materials for specific uses.	<u>Maths</u> In numeracy we will be learning about number and place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division, fractions, measures, geometry and statistics. We will be looking at reasoning and different problem solving activities. We will be recording maths in many different ways and will be using lots of practical equipment.	<u>Religious Education</u> We will be learning about ‘Belonging’ And also celebrations within different beliefs. <u>PHSCE</u> We will learning about ‘New Beginnings’ How to keep ourselves healthy. Also friendship and how we are all different.
<u>PE</u> <u>Indoor:</u> Dance—we will represent a number of stories through dance. <u>Outdoor:</u> Games—we will be focusing on developing throwing and catching skills. <u>Theme</u> The theme during Autumn term is ‘The Great Fire of London.’ We will be looking at the causes of the fire and the role Samuel Pepys played in recording happenings in a diary and shaping our knowledge of the event. We will also be looking at The Great Fire of Gateshead and Newcastle which will include a visit to St Mary’s church to the Heritage Centre where we will find out more about this local historical event.	<u>English</u> This term we will be looking at stories with familiar settings. We will also read a range of familiar stories. We will be retelling and adapting some of the stories we read. Also instructions and poetry. Grammar: consistent use of capital letters, full stops, exclamation marks, question marks, commas and speech marks. Word group: Verbs, adverbs, prepositions, adjectives, time conjunctions, similes and alliteration.	<u>Additional Information</u> Outdoor PE will be every Friday (If the weather is permitting) and Indoor PE will be every Monday.
