Remote Education

What your child will be offered if school is closed:

- You will receive an email from your child's class teacher to confirm that your child's education will continue remotely, attached to this will be a child friendly remote learning document for you to share with your child
- Please inform the school office (<u>office@wallsendjubileeps.org.uk</u>) if you do not have a device such as a phone, laptop or tablet for remote learning. We will aim to keep activities practical where we can to eliminate the need to work online.
- Your child's class teacher will communicate with you and your child on a daily basis through Tapestry.
- On day 1 of self-isolation parents are directed to The Oak Academy for generic activities for your child to access and complete
- From day 2 until the end of the self-isolation teachers will set a schedule of work for each day on Tapestry. This will be 4 activities, including one phonics activity. You will also be sent some stories via Tapestry to share with your child over and over again.
- Where possible we ask that your child submits a photo of their learning on Tapestry. This can be daily updates or a weekly summary on a Friday. If you are struggling to access work or upload photographs please let us know as we may contact parents that we do not hear from.
- Any submitted work will receive feedback from the class teacher or class teaching assistant
- You and your child can email any questions or queries regarding the set work during school working hours to the class teacher. Your class teachers will respond at the earliest convenience. Please bear in mind they will be teaching key worker children and so may not be able to give an immediate response.
