	A headline
	The 5Ws (Who/where/what/when/why)
	Chronological order of the events (the order in which they happened) (Try to use time adverbials to help organise your writing – for example – Early yesterday morning... Later that day...)
	Powerful descriptions to make the events seem dramatic
	Quotes from people who were there (Remember to use your speech punctuation and synonyms for said, for example – “The airmen were screaming for help!” exclaimed one of the young boys who found them.)

Remember to write it in the past tense!
