You can join through a shared link off your teachers site, an email, or their blog.





- Check video
 - Make sure the background is appropriate
 - You are wearing appropriate clothing and not in PJ's
 - Remember call in rooms that are NOT your bedroom / bathroom (Cybersmart rule)
 - Make sure you have an adult in the room with you
- Check sound
 - Mute the mic before you join
