ATTENDANCE AND PUNCTUALITY

Attendance and punctuality are so important in our school and absence can have a massive effect on your child's learning. I understand as a parent myself, that there are occasions when your child is ill and cannot come to school, but I urge you to support the school with its current drive to improve the overall attendance rate in school.

With this in mind, we will shortly be looking closely at attendance and you will all receive a letter informing you of your child's attendance percentage since the start of the school year. This letter will inform you if your child's attendance is in the green, amber or red zone. All red zone attendance will be monitored for a four week period to ensure improvements are made The school's ambition is that all children have attendance as near to 95% as possible

Winter Weather procedures

As you will have noticed we have just had our first morning frosts of the season and our weather is getting colder. Mr Brand will be working extremely hard over the next few months to ensure our site is safe and open to all children. Our yards can quickly become iced over so where possible Mr Brand will grit the patches of ice.

However sometimes ice forms after he has done this, so I urge you to be careful as you walk across the yards as it is impossible to grit 100% of all the yards.

If a pathway is gritted and we feel the rest of the yard is too slippy, the school doors will be open at 8.45am and your children can come straight into school. Please ensure that you and your children make every effort to use the pathways provided as we cannot take responsibility if someone slips in areas outside the paths provided.

If we assess that the yards are too dangerous due to ice and/or snow we will clear a path to the front entrance and the children will come into school that way. Thankyou for your cooperation.
