



<u>Science</u> In Science this term we will be Learning about animals, including humans, and their habitats. We will compare animals and observe how they are suited to their environment.	<u>Maths</u> In numeracy we will be learning about number and place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division, fractions, measures, geometry and statistics. We will be looking at problem solving and different problem solving activities. We will be recording maths in many different ways and will be deepening our reasoning skills.	<u>Religious Education</u> We will be learning about the Easter story, we will understand why we celebrate Easter.
<u>PE</u> <u>Indoor:</u> Dance—children will be taught a range of movements to sequence. Grammar: consistent use of capital letters, full stops, exclamation marks, apostrophes, question marks, commas and inverted commas. Word groups: Verbs, adverbs, prepositions, adjectives, time conjunctions, conjunctions, similes and alliteration.	<u>ICT</u> In ICT we will using software to find facts and present them in different ways.
