Aaron got a new friend during lockdown for his birthday. He is called Alfie."






I've been having fun playing outside, baking & doing my drawings! Missing all my friends but excited to see you all soon. Love Jasmine.



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
Hi all my reception friends. I have missed you and I'm looking forward to playing with you in September. I love puddle jumping. Splash!!!
