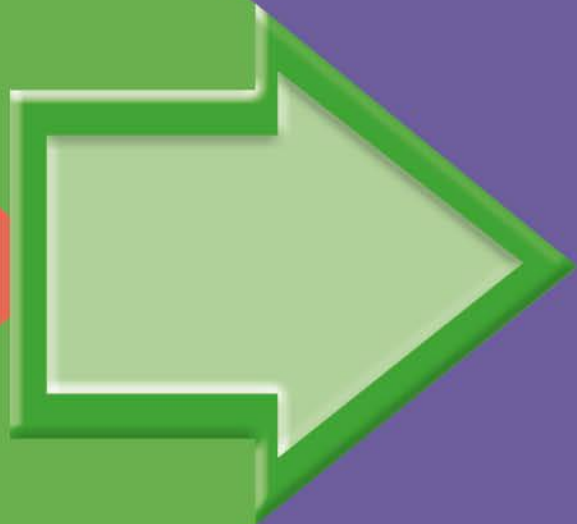
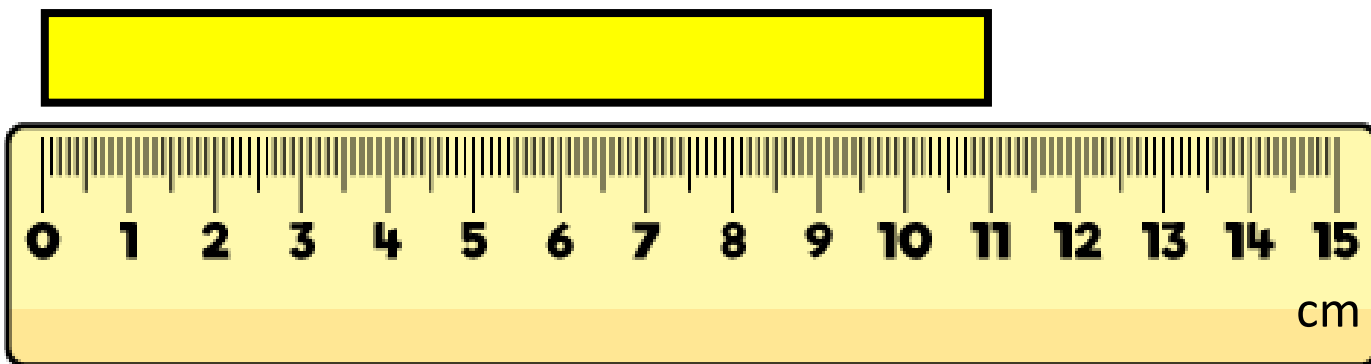


# MEASURE PERIMETER

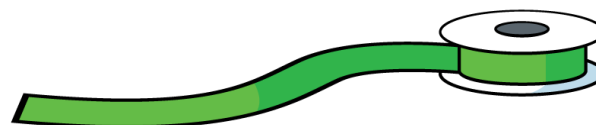

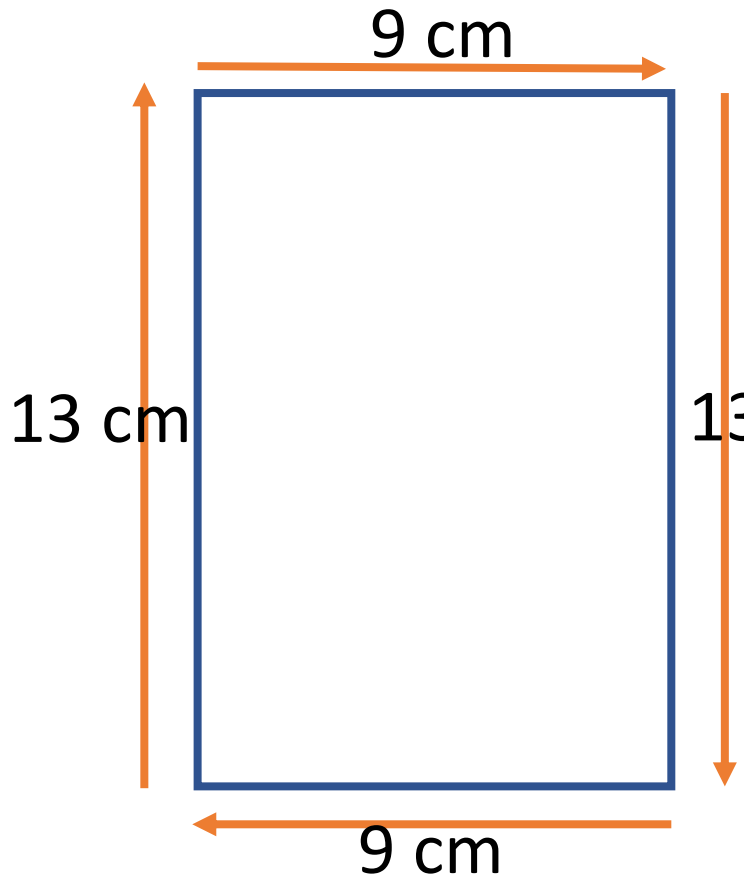

Perimeter is the total length around the edge of a 2-D shape.



The perimeter  
of the rectangle  
is 22 cm.





$$\underbrace{9 \text{ cm} + 13 \text{ cm}}_{22 \text{ cm}} + \underbrace{9 \text{ cm} + 13 \text{ cm}}_{22 \text{ cm}} = 44 \text{ cm}$$
