As our children finish this half term we wish you all a safe, happy, and well deserved break and hope you enjoy reading about their successes.

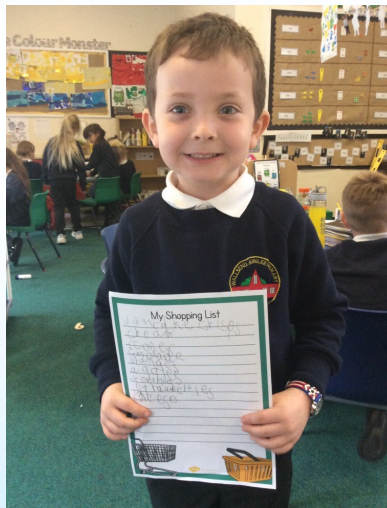
Our Year 1 classes





English

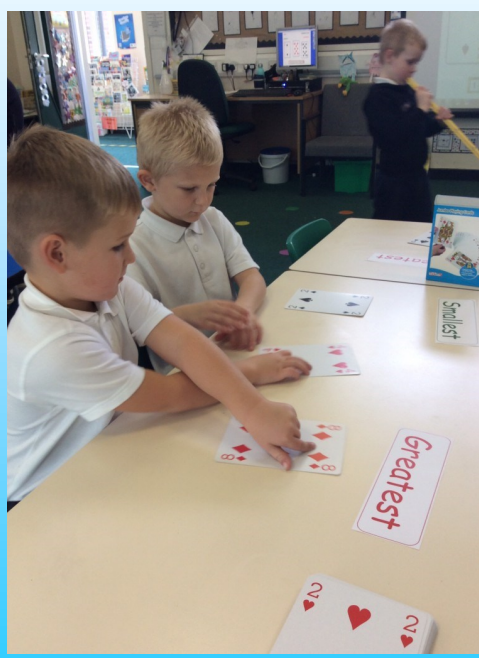
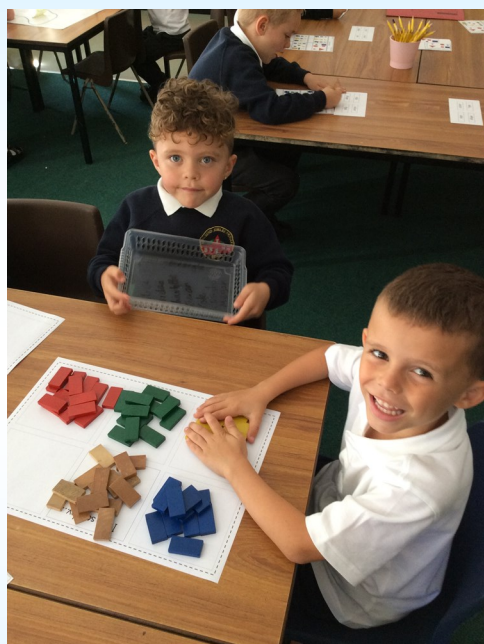
In English we have looked at a variety of stories, some all about feelings and some about settings. We went to Space with Whatever Next and we have enjoyed reading The Tiger who came to tea. We have focused on writing sentences remembering capital letters, full stops and finger spaces. We have written lists for packing and shopping. We have practiced sounding out words and clapping sentences aloud to hold a sentence in our heads. We have had our daily sessions of RWI to help us learn new sounds and apply them to our reading.





Maths

We have been very busy in Maths this term! We started by sorting objects into different groups; colour, size, type and shape. We then moved on to focus on numbers to 10- counting forwards and backwards up to and from 10, one more/ one less, ordering numbers from smallest to greatest and counting/ ordering numbers to 10.

We read the colour monster story and learnt about the different emotions. We created mood pictures and made some feelings jars.

Religious Education

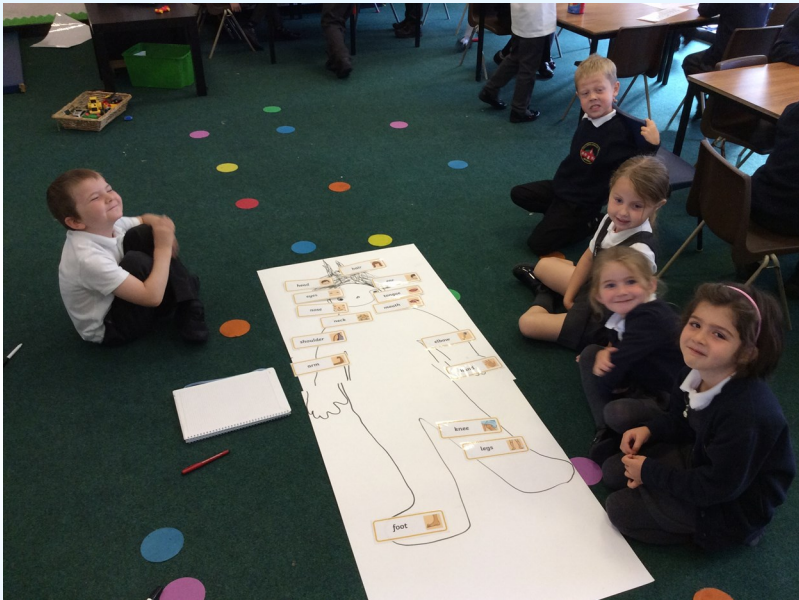

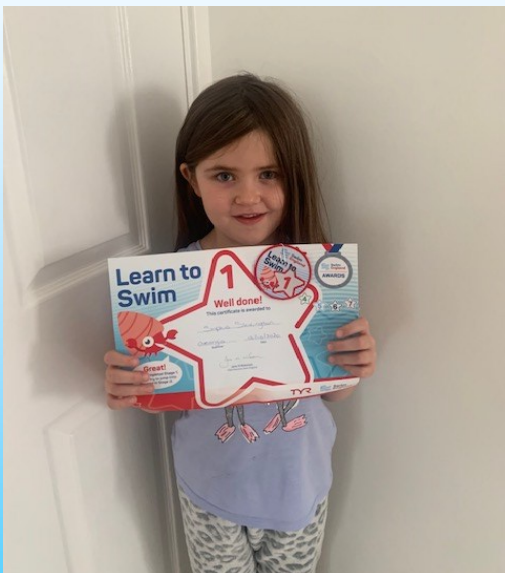
Awards, Achievements & Celebrations

If I went to the moon I would take my Mam and Dad. I love them.

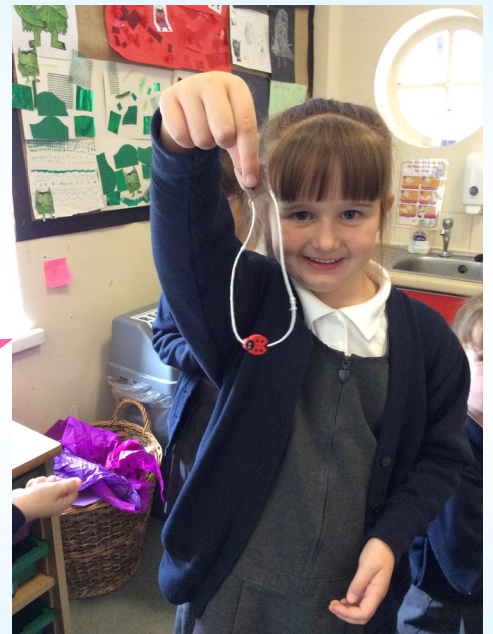


You are at the feelings station. 'Today I put it in love. I love school and I love Kai. I do love my Dad and my dog too.'

You enjoyed making a kite in the craft area with your friends.

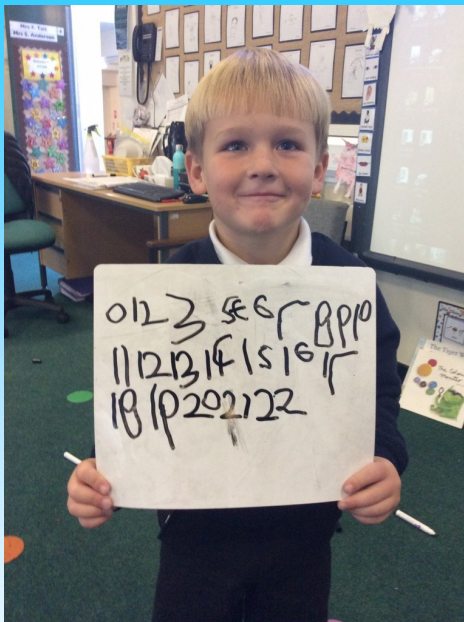


I like playing in the small world. I love the tiger 'ggrrr' he is chasing the dog. I like playing with the animals . I like dinosaurs too.

Look I've made Iron Man's hand, he's a superhero you know. I love superheroes. I like drawing and colouring in Year 1

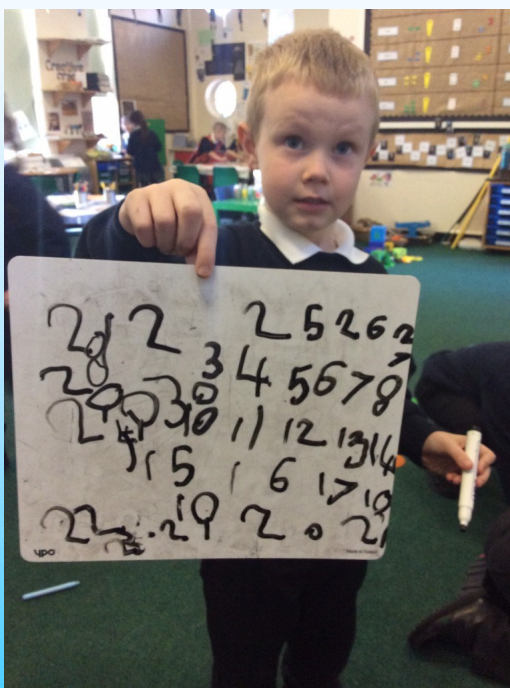


This is my rocket, it's got boosters on so it can fly high. The flames are coming out the bottom of the boosters, when you press the boosters the rocket can speed to the moon"

You made the red colour monster. "He is red cos he is angry, he has a cross face".

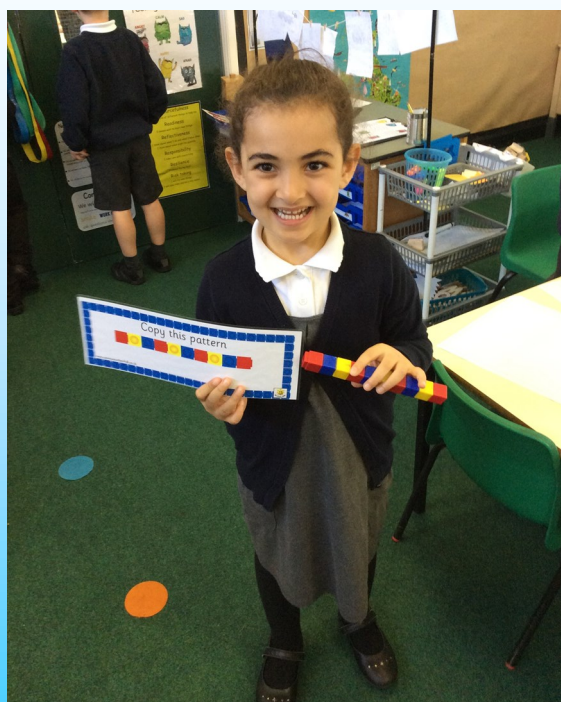


You love playing in the small world with the dolls.

You loved making your colour monster. The blue monster has a sad face.

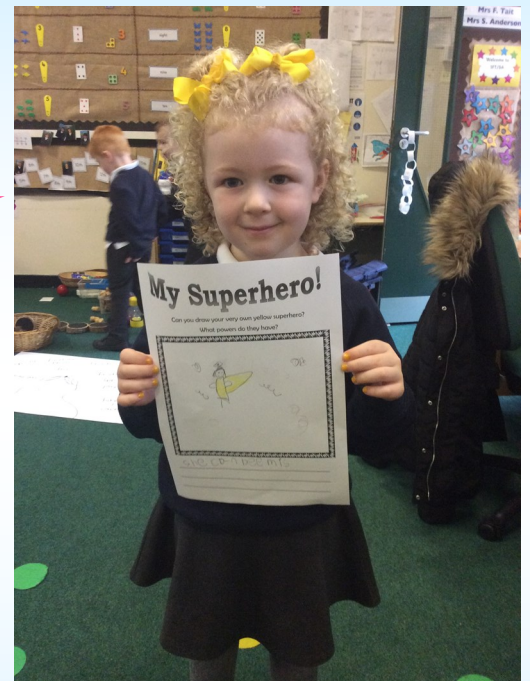


You love Maths and you made the repeating pattern.

The floor is Lava! You had a great time in our outdoor area building obstacle courses and using planks to make bridges.

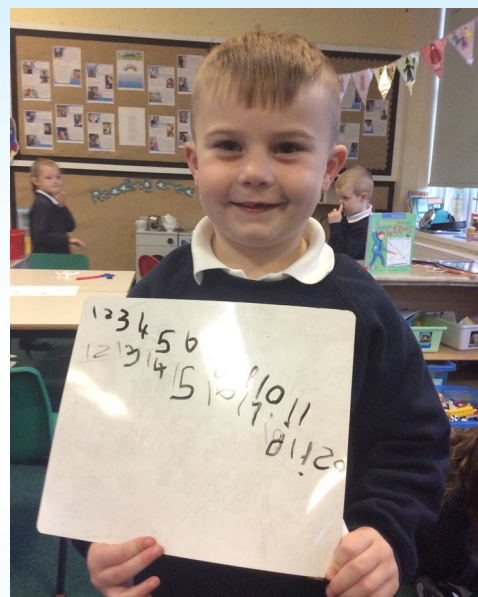


I like making things. I made a bracelet. I like painting in the craft area with my friends Siella and Sophia.

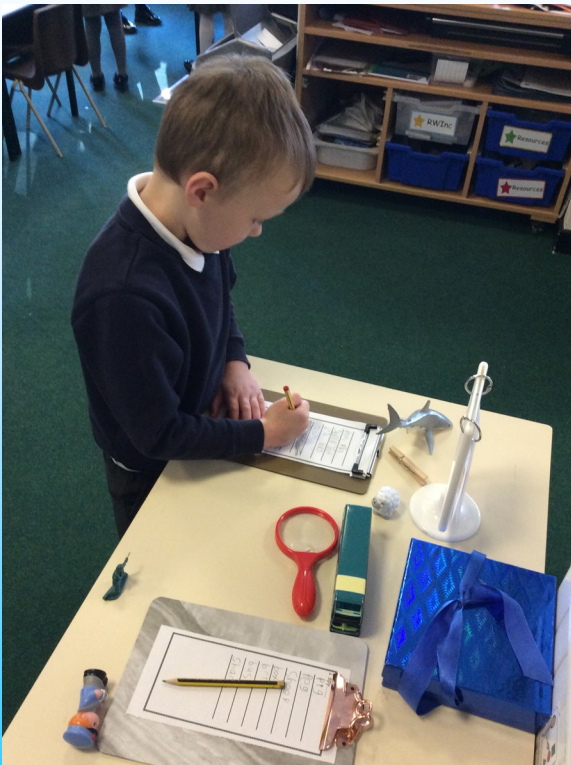


You were searching around the classroom for different coloured objects. You were making a list of them and then telling us about how each colour makes you feel.

You spent all week making this amazing aeroplane in the junk modelling area. You were so proud of your creation, well done Blake!



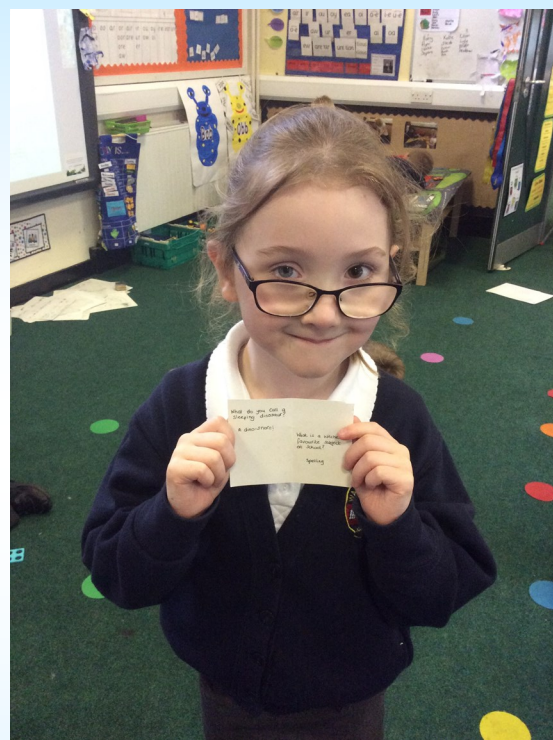
You have started to have a go at all the extra English and Maths challenges that we put out. Keep up the great work Donnie!

You enjoyed reading 'The Ten Little Superheroes' story to the children on the carpet. You included lots of expression and loud noises!



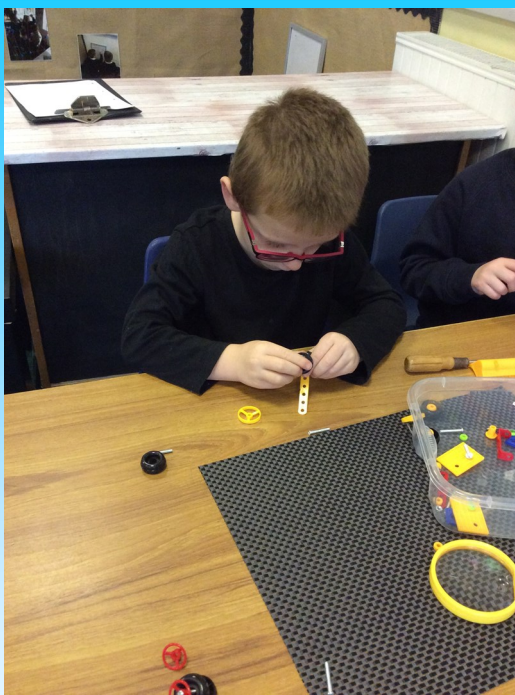
'It's a castle. There is a handle and a drawbridge so you can walk in and out. This is where you have to dry your feet before you walk in. There is a garden.'

You worked really hard at this Maths challenge to find one more/ one less than the number in the house. You were very proud of your work!



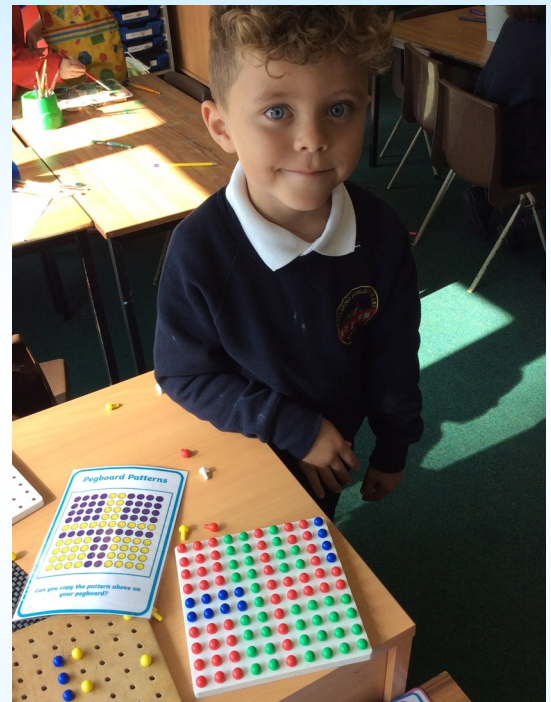
You enjoyed this English challenge. You were writing what the different characters might say in the speech bubbles.

You and Georgina were working away at the tinker table. You were using the screw drivers to make a car out of all the fiddly parts!

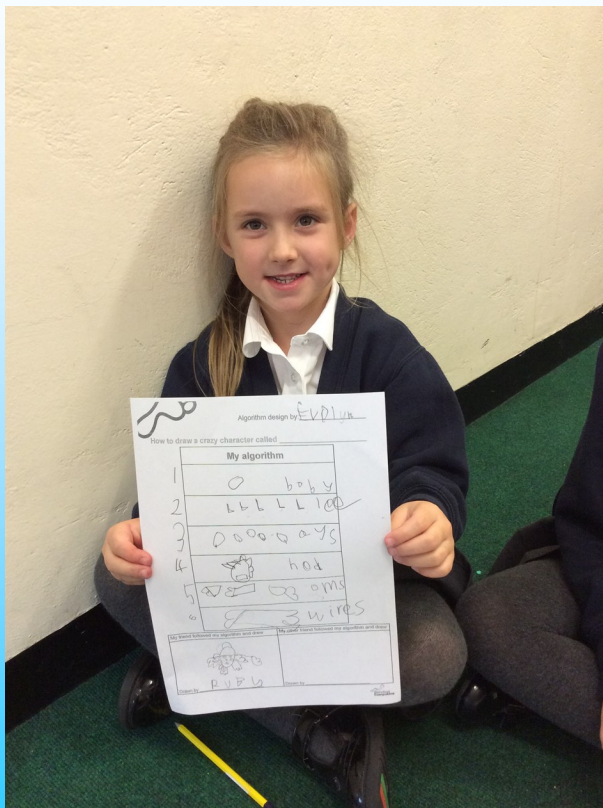


You and Poppy made little cats in the arts and crafts area! You used string to make a lead and walked them around the classroom.

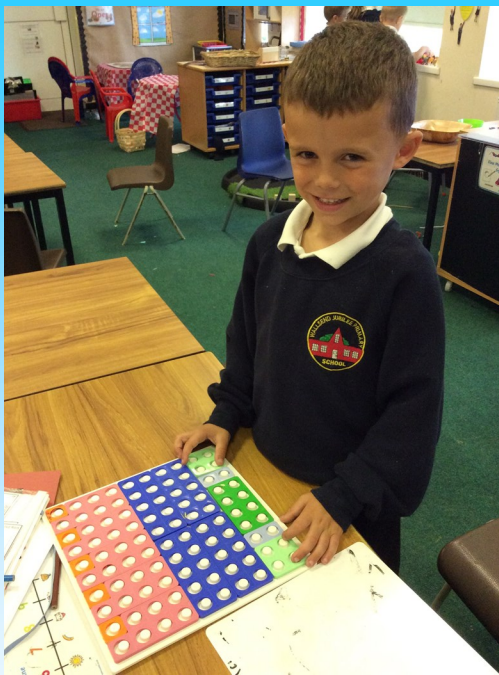


You, Jenson and Teddy had a great time colouring in our giant ark for our Noah's Ark display!
