Counting backwards can be useful – especially if you want to make a rocket take off!

10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1    BLAST OFF!


BUT what happens when we are counting backwards and we get to '0'?

2. From 8, count back 12.





3. From 7, count back 15.




