



<u>Science</u> We will be looking at ourselves, our senses and parts of the body. We will be identifying and naming common animals. We will be looking at the seasons, describing the weather and seasonal change. 	<u>Maths</u> In Maths we will cover place value, addition and subtraction and shape. Within place value we will be focussing on numbers up to 20; counting forwards and backwards and comparing numbers. We will be using lots of practical equipment to add and subtract within 20 and we will also be identifying and recognising 2D and 3D shapes.	<u>Religious Education</u> This term we will be learning about different stories from the Old Testament in the Bible. <u>PHSCE</u> Rules and the need for rules will form an important part of our work this term. We will be looking at new beginnings focusing on feelings, attitude and how to treat others.	
<u>PE</u> In outdoor PE we will be learning how to play a range of games focusing on ball skills such as throwing and catching. In indoor PE we are taking part in gymnastics and dance. We will also be learning how to create digital sounds and digital art.

Children will design and make their own home using different materials. 	<u>English</u> This term we will be looking at stories with a familiar setting, instructions, recounts, rhyming stories and poems. The main focus is independent writing of sentences with capital letters and full stops. We will be encouraging children to read independently with fluency through individual and shared reading.
