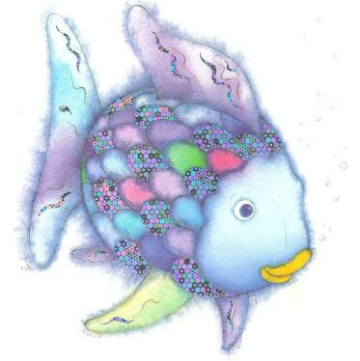

Task 1: Can you think of some adjectives (WOW) words to describe the Rainbow Fish? Here are some of my ideas to help you.

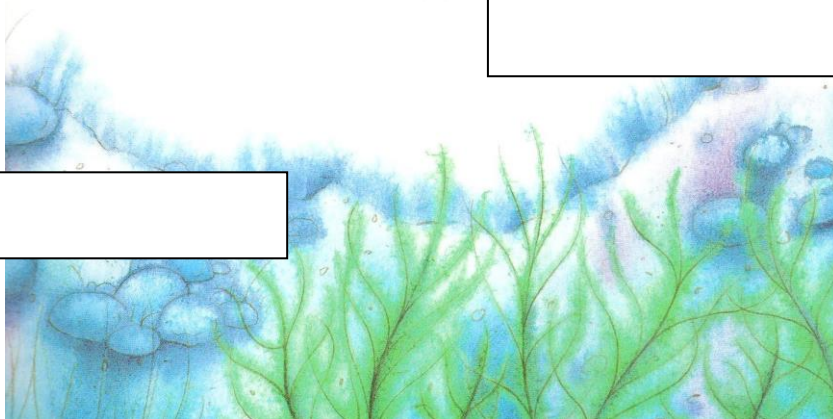
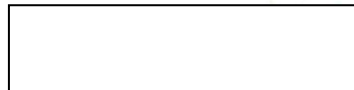
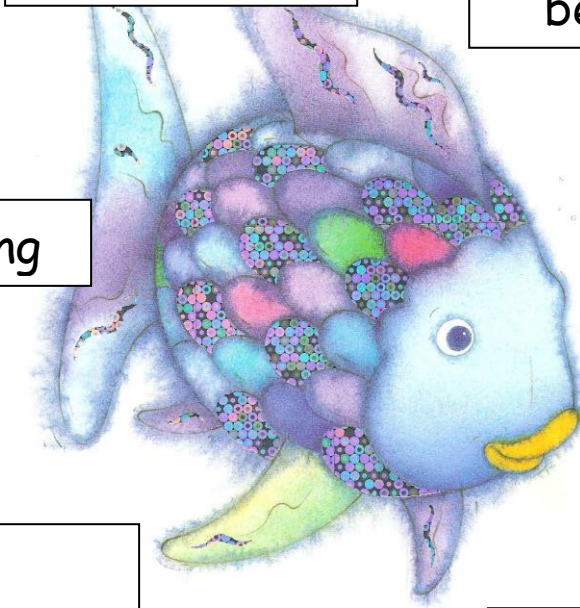

Task 2: Use your adjectives to write 5 WOW sentences. Remember capital letters and full stops! Extend your sentences using 'and'.

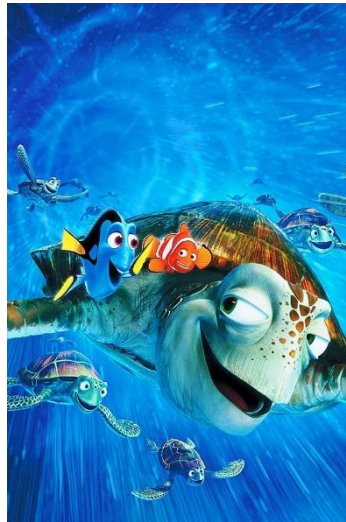
Here is an example; *The bright blue sea sparkled in the sunlight and the little, green turtle swam to see his friends.*

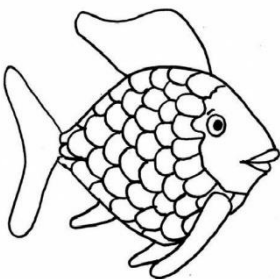
Dear Children,
