






What else do you think Grendel is going to wish for?



He was just about to wish the WHOLE WORLD was chocolate when he stopped... No. He had to be SENSIBLE.


"I know!" he said. "I wish ... everything I *touch* turns to chocolate!"




Can you see any other problems Grendel will have?
