The picture we described yesterday is from the Amazonian Rainforest which is under threat because of climate change. Read the following text about a young girl who has become famous for speaking about climate change. Then answer the questions underneath.

Greta Thunberg

Greta Thunberg is a young girl from Sweden. Over the past few years she has become famous because she speaks out about climate change.

Greta, who was born in 2003, started to become worried about climate change at the age of just eight. She became extremely sad and could not



understand why so little was being done about it. To lower her family's carbon footprint, she insisted they become vegan and give up flying, but she wanted to make a bigger impact.

When she was fifteen she began spending her school days outside the Swedish parliament demanding they take action to fight against climate change. Nobody seemed to take any notice so she started a school strike for climate which then began to attract media attention.

These school strikes spread around the world and in March 2019, an estimated 1.4 million students in 112 countries joined her in striking and protesting. More recently, she has been nominated for the Nobel Peace Prize and was featured on the cover of Time magazine.
