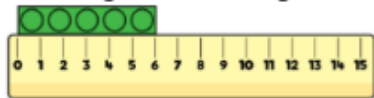


Can I measure length?

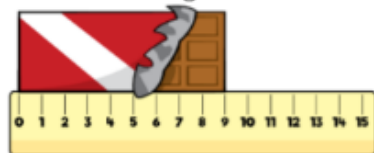

The red straw is cm tall.

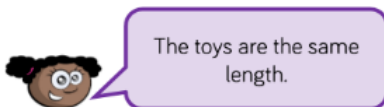
The straw is the tallest.

Whitney measures the length of two toys.

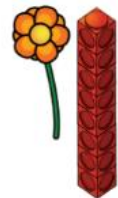


She says,

Answers

The building block is 6cm

The chocolate is 9cm

The blue straw is 6cm

The red straw is 8cm

The red straw is the tallest.

The blue straw is the shortest.

True or false?



False because the cubes should be level with the bottom of the flower. The flower is about 6 cubes tall.

The flower is 8 cubes tall.
Explain your answer.

Whitney measures the length of two toys.



She says,



The toys are the same length.

Do you agree with Whitney?
Explain your answer.

Whitney is wrong. Both toys are 4 units long, but the rubber and the cubes are different lengths so the toys are not the same length.
