Matthew you chose a numeral, counted out the objects and found the corresponding piece of numicon.





Poppy and Amelia you were choosing two bowls and identifying which bowl had more and which bowl had less objects.

Logan and Rafa you enjoyed chatting together as you were modelling.




Millie, Lacie and Reaho you spent lots of time exploring your dough together.





Here you are creating your own model Lee!






You were a bit cheeky Ollie as you decided which children in your class had been bad and had to go to jail. You marked them down on your register!


