HOW TO MAKE A WATER XYLOPHONE



Explore pitch using this fun creation!

- 1. Grab some empty plastic bottles
- 2. Fill each bottle with a different amount of water and place them in order from fullest to emptiest.
- 3. (Optional) Add a drop of food colouring to each bottle to create a rainbow design.
- 4. Gently blow across the top of each bottle to create a 'note' which notes had the highest pitch? Which notes had the lowest pitch?
- 5. Recreate your favourite songs on your water xylophone!

Extension – can you add extra 'keys' to your xylophone by adding extra bottles and filling them with the correct amount of water?
