I can identify features of instructions.

What is the purpose of instructions?

Instructions tell us how to do something. There are many different types of instructions. Some examples include:

- *recipes
- *directions
- *how to play a game
- *how to make or build something
- *how to look after/care for something

Regardless of their purpose instructions share many of the same features:

- *they usually have an introduction to explain what the end result will be
- *they usually include a list of things that the reader will need
- *they will also tell you how you are going to complete the task.

How to make juicy jam sandwiches

Follow these wonderful steps and you will end up with delicious, sweet and sticky jam sandwiches perfect for a lunch time treat

Ingredients

2 slices of bread
Butter or margarine
Strawberry Jam

Equipment

Plate
Knife
spoon



Method

1. First, use the knife to spread the butter onto one side of both slices of bread.
2. After that, scoop a spoonful of Jam onto one slice of bread
3. Then, smoothly spread the jam onto one slice of bread.
4. After, place the buttered bread onto the jammed bread.
5. Gently press the bread together
6. Next carefully cut your sandwich
7. Finally place your sandwich on a plate

You should now have a delicious jam sandwich.
