

## Welcome to Tuesday!

Today we are adding amounts of money to find the total.

## TASK 1:

First of all we need to look at converting pence to pounds and pence.

How many pennies are there in £1? There are 100 pennies in £1







How can this fact help us to convert between pounds and pence?

How could you convert 600p into pounds?

You group the pennies into groups of 100.

Therefore 600 would be 6 groups of 100 so it is £6.



How could you convert 620p into pounds.

Here we have 6 groups of 100 which makes £6 but there are 20 pennies left over so we write is using a decimal point after the pounds £6.20

Write each amount in pounds and pence

- 1) 345p = £3.45
- 2) 456p
- 3) 879p
- 4) 327p
- 5) 218p
- 6) 876p

## TASK 2:

Try a couple of the questions on the worksheet labelled Counting coins. The answers are there at the end to help you.

CHALLENGE! Try and research different charities and how much it costs to adopt various wildlife. (WWF, Guide Dogs) Put the amounts in order in £ and pence, then convert to pence only.
