Today we are adding amounts of money to find the total.

### TASK 1:

First of all we need to look at converting pence to pounds and pence.

How many pennies are there in £1? **There are 100 pennies in £1**



is the same as

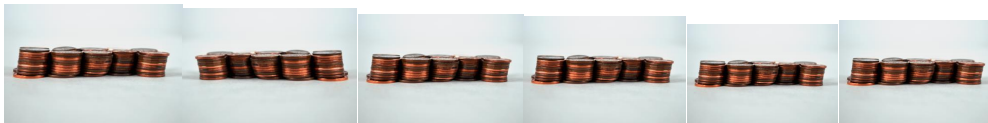


*How can this fact help us to convert between pounds and pence?*

How could you convert 600p into pounds?

*You group the pennies into groups of 100.*

*Therefore 600 would be 6 groups of 100 so it is £6.*



How could you convert 620p into pounds.

Here we have 6 groups of 100 which makes £6 but there are 20 pennies left over so we write it using a decimal point after the pounds **£6.20**

Write each amount in pounds and pence

1) 345p = £3.45

2) 456p

3) 879p

4) 327p

5) 218p

6) 876p

## **TASK 2:**
