



Science

We will cover two units this term:

Habitats and Living Things: We will learn about animals and their habitats with a big focus on classification of living things and how to group living things into categories.

Space & Forces: We will learn about the Solar System and beyond, as well as the cycles of the Moon, how the Earths rotation affects seasons and we will also study famous British astronauts.

PE

Games (Outdoor): We will learn simple invasion tactics and start to think about how to organise ourselves to defend our goals, playing small, uneven-sided games, and move on to even-sided games.

Theme

The theme during the Autumn term is The Ancient Greeks. During this theme we will look at the history and culture of the Ancient Greek period. The children will find out about Greek society and culture. They will also take part in a variety of art and design activities. The children will also be learning about primary and secondary sources and their relevance to finding out about history.

Maths

In maths we will cover elements of place value, fractions, decimals and calculations.

We will be spending an extended amount of time looking at number and place value. We will also be calculating larger numbers using a range of practical and written methods. This term the children will be encouraged to learn their times tables up to 12x12. The children will be thinking about describing numbers, (e.g odd/even, greater than/less than, multiples of.) while improving their skills used to develop the mastery of Maths.

Religious Education

We will be learning about sacred books this term and studying Judaism and Christianity.

PHSCE

We will be looking at New Beginnings including Rules and the needs for rules which will form an

important part of our work this term. We will exploring friendships, conflict resolution and the importance of positive relationships and wellbeing.

ICT

In ICT we will be programing retro games using platforms such as Scratch. They will learn how to code and write

algorithms and identify problems within codes and learn how to solve them.

French

In French your child will be learning to say and recognise numbers up to 30. They will learn how to say the weather and tell the time.

English

This term we will be covering a variety of elements of narrative which will be focussing on stories with a historical setting and stories set in imaginary worlds. Non fiction texts, such as recounts (newspapers and magazines) as well as poetry will also be studied.

Grammar: Consistent use of a range of punctuation. Extending sentences through use of a wide range of connectives. Use of nouns and pronouns to avoid repetition in writing.
