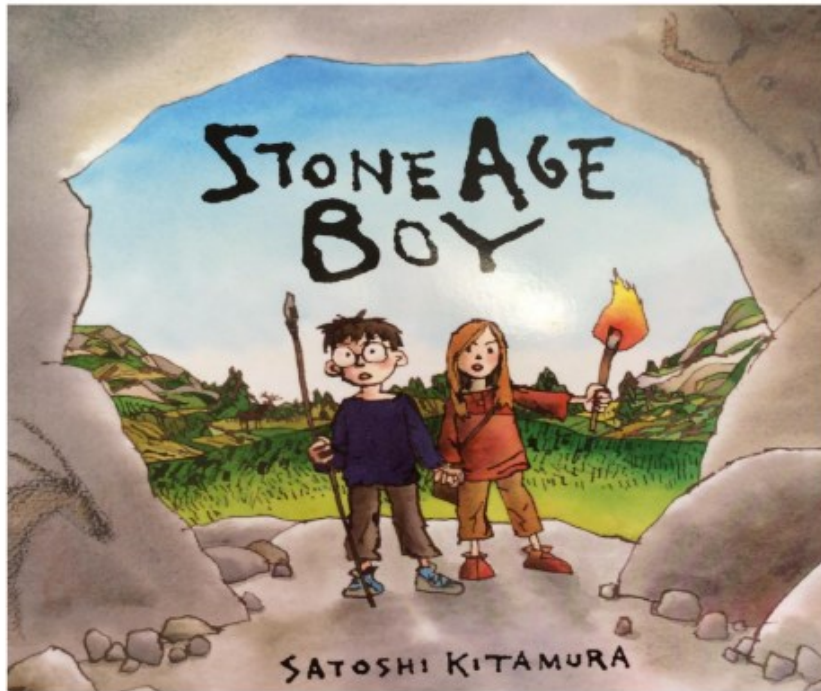

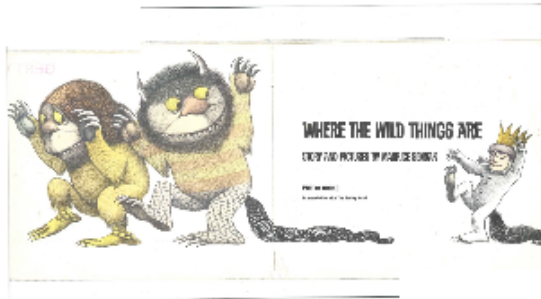
I can identify the text type and it's features.

Is Stone Age Boy similar to any other stories that we have read this year?



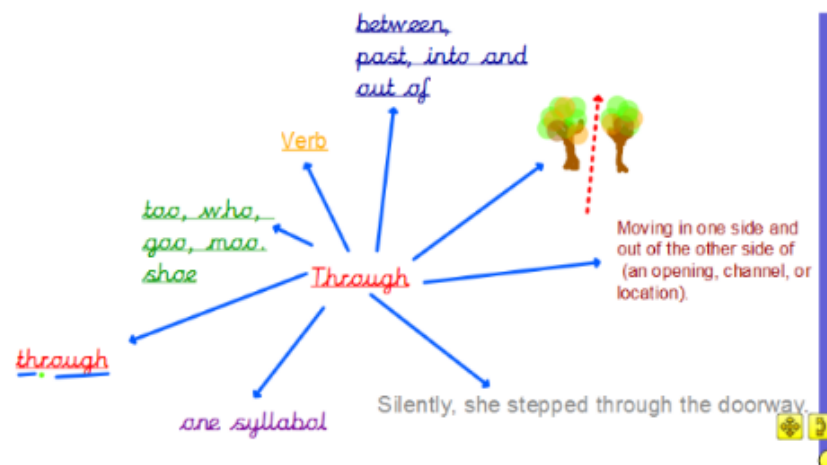
We read Where the Wild Thing Are at the beginning of the year. Write down any similarities that you have found between the two books.
